

# The Facts About the Horseracing Integrity & Safety Act (HISA)

The HISA focuses on  
**Thoroughbreds** only.

The board will be composed of **nine** conflict of interest-free, **five** independent, and **four** equine industry members.

The board will create **three standing committees** – medication and anti-doping, racetrack safety, and an independent nominating committee.

The Federal Trade Commission will provide limited **oversight.**

HISA requires the creation of a **national racetrack safety program.**

The bill creates **HISA Authority**, which will be an independent, not-for-profit, self-regulatory organization run by an **independent board.**

The HISA includes both **medication control** and **racetrack safety.**

The United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) will enforce **the authority's rules**, oversee **laboratory testing**, and handle **violations matters.** USADA already manages the anti-doping programs for **America's Olympic athletes.**

The HISA establishes **baseline medication rules** based upon international standards.
